1. Introduction

Its 21 Member Countries are Angola, Botswana, Burundi, Eritrea, Eswatini, Ethiopia, Kenya, Lesotho, Madagascar, Malawi, Mauritius, Mozambique, Namibia, Rwanda, Seychelles, South Africa, South Sudan, Tanzania, Uganda, Zambia and Zimbabwe and includes a number of regional and international observers such as Commonwealth Secretariat, East African Community, FATF, IMF, SADC, United Kingdom, United States of America, UNODC ,World Bank and World .

3. Delivery Terms

Delivery point: ESAAMLG Office, Madaraka Street, Dar es Salaam, Tanzania.

The supplier shall deliver all twenty-five (25) laptops to the specified ESAAMLG Office. The quoted price shall include all costs necessary to complete delivery at that location, including transportation, loading and unloading, and applicable taxes and duties as required by the applicable procurement arrangements and law.

Following delivery, ESAAMLG shall inspect and accept the laptops, record serial numbers and relevant asset information, and coordinate onward distribution to the designated beneficiary FIUs. Onward distribution is an ESAAMLG implementation and asset-management responsibility and is not part of the supplier's delivery obligation under this RFQ.

4. DELIVERY SCHEDULE

Delivery must be completed within thirty (30) calendar days from the date of the Purchase Order/Contract. Suppliers shall state their proposed delivery lead time in calendar days.

All quotations and supporting documentation must be submitted in English.

Quotations will be evaluated using the Lowest Evaluated Responsive Bidder Method. Evaluation will be conducted in four sequential stages. ESAAMLG reserves the right to accept any item or group of items from an offer and may make an award for a quantity that is less than what is specified in the RFQ, at the unit prices quoted.

ESAAMLG may reject any quotation deemed non-responsive. A responsive quotation is one that meets all terms and conditions of the RFQ, is complete, duly signed by an authorized representative, and submitted

by the deadline indicated on the cover page of this RFQ. ESAAMLG reserves the right to waive minor, non-material discrepancies in a quotation at its sole discretion.
